1. Pursuant to request in preceding 8th Indorsement, a letter was addressed to the Governor of the State of Arizona on 6 October 1953 to which no reply was received, several attempts were made to draw out the Governor, but he did not choose to commit himself. Following the newspaper account of the reactivation of Fort Huachuca by the U. S. Signal Corps another letter was hand-carried to the Governor, upon receipt of which he requested a conference.

2. At a conference held in the Governor's office 29 January 1954, Governor Howard L. Pyle expressed his willingness to execute a deed or deeds reconveying the real and personal property comprising Fort Huachuca Military Reservation, Artillery Range and Cemetery and Access roads thereto to the United States. Inclosed herewith is copy of letter addressed to the Governor 31 January 1954 and Memorandum Report on conference held 29 January 1954.
