This program of 10 items was submitted by the station to the Test and Evaluation Command. The Test and Evaluation Command deferred all but the first item based on the Department of the Army dollar guidance furnished by way of the Army Material Command to the Test and Evaluation Command.

The first item, the BOQ, was for 103 spaces. It was submitted by the Test and Evaluation Command to Army Material Command and from Army Material Command to the Department of the Army at that scope, namely 103 spaces. Department of the Army submitted the project to the Department of Defense at a price of \$602,000 for 80 BOQ spaces. The Department of Defense cut the Army's project \$320,000 for 40 spaces, and that is before Congress now.

There is a long-range deficit of 88 spaces.
