ELECTRONICS PROVING GROUND  
IS ESTABLISHED AT HUACHUCA

The Department of the Army announced today the establishment of the United States Army Electronic Proving Ground at Fort Huachuca, Arizona.

Signal Corps electronic and aviation activities require more experimental space than is available at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey, where they have been heretofore located. The area of Fort Huachuca, in standby status since June of 1953, was selected as the only suitable and economical site of the many studied.

The major Signal Corps activities at Fort Monmouth, including research and development laboratories and the Signal Corps School, remain unaffected by this transfer.
