My dear Senator:

I have this date transmitted to the Honorable Jess Larson, Director, General Services Administration, through Major General Kenneth F. Cramer, Chief, National Guard Bureau, a formal request asking that the State of Arizona be permitted to sell buildings and improvements located in Cantonment Areas 10 and 13 of the Fort Huachuca Military Reservation.

It has been indicated that the request would receive favorable consideration from Mr. Larson and the Secretary of the Army; however, I would personally appreciate your following up the progress of this request.

The funds that will be derived from the sale will be expended at Fort Huachuca, in accordance with the terms of the deed that conveyed the built-up areas to the National Guard, in maintaining the portions of the old post and that of the cantonment area necessary for the housing and training of the National Guard of Arizona.
