Dear Mr. Mitchell:

Pursuant to your request of 22 June 1949, I am inclosing herewith copy of Classification Map of the cantonment area at Fort Huachuca showing thereon the numbered areas and their boundaries.

The numbered areas are referred to in the Deed that transferred Fort Huachuca to the State of Arizona. As a quick reference, at the bottom of page 3 of the Deed it refers to a water distribution system contained in areas 1 to 6. This specifically refers to what is termed the Old Post Area of Fort Huachuca. Areas 7 to 14 inclusive are the built-up areas sometimes referred to as the New Cantonment Area or the Cantonment Area, except for permanent fixtures as wells, pumping plants, sewage disposal plants. Practically all of the construction is frame in the Areas 7 to 14 inclusive.

As you pointed out in our discussion, the water distribution system, the electrical distribution system, and the sewage distribution system were all transferred to the National Guard of Arizona by virtue of the Deed and, of course, they were enumerated in the original application signed by the Governor in November 1948.

As you recall, Mr. Robert Kelly stated that the buildings had been sold in Areas 8, 9, 11 and 12 excepting such buildings as were reserved for use of the Guard and Fish and Game Commission, and that are enumerated in the Deed. The State, or I should say the National Guard, did acquire all the water pipe lines located in the areas 1 to 14 inclusive. In addition, the State or National Guard receive all the gas pipe used in the distribution system in Areas 1 to 7 inclusive; and in addition, that pipe located in Areas 10, 13 and 14. The sale that was held November 1st consisted of the gas pipe of the gas distribution system in Areas 8, 9, 11 and 12.



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The question you raised relative to the sale of pipe that was made by the National Guard under date of 25 May 1949 can be best explained by the attached Invitation for Bids and Specifications of Sale dated 20 April 1949. You will note that only certain pipe could be purchased that was located in Areas 9, 10, 12 and 14; and in addition certain transite pipe located in Area 8.
