

Word has reached us that a controversy has arisen over the signing of the lease of certain portions of the Fort Huachuca installation to a non-profit corporation - FORT HUACHUCA, INC. - for the dual purpose of maintaining the installation and furnishing low-rental housing to disabled veterans, health seekers, and others in need of such housing.

This controversy is, apparently, holding up signature of the lease, thus delaying the functions mentioned above, both of which are of vital importance to the people of the State, particularly to residents of this area.

It is urged that you give the fullest possible support to the corporation, and that you not delay signing the lease on the said portions of the Fort Huachuca installation.
