EXCEPT THE Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) thereof.

Subject to: Existing taxes, assessments, liens, encumbrances, covenants, conditions, restrictions, rights of way and easements of record.
