Dear Mr. Balmer:

Reference is made to Office letter, Emergency Conservation, June 23, advising you that \$7,000 has been set up for well drilling on the Western Navajo.

Mr. Neuffer has obtained the approval of the following well locations on the Western Navajo, which information is submitted to you in the hope that it may be useful in getting the well drilling started at an early date, inasmuch as it is a drought relief measure. The following locations are indefinite inasmuch as it will be necessary for Mr. Womack to pass upon the exact location from a geological standpoint. However, Mr. Boyle of the Soil Erosion Service has designated these locations as being desirable from a range management standpoint.
