WORK DONE AND RESULTS:

Surveys were made for a reservoir site near Fort Defiance to store water on a tributary of Bonito Creek. The project was considered impracticable on account of the large amount of silt and the small size of the reservoir.

In 1922 additional surveys were made and on representations by the superintendent at Fort Defiance of the cost of forage, basing the life of the reservation at ten years, and it being maintained by him that within the period of ten years he could raise enough alfalfa to more than pay for the project, it was recommended. No action has been taken by the Indian Office regarding it.
