WORK DONE AND RESULTS:

Ditch built by Indian Office in 1905-6. Diversion dam built in stream by Superintendent of Irrigation Butler, a supply ditch from stream to reservoir site, and reservoir was commenced. Reservoir completed in 1910 and ditch built to convey water to land. No use has been made of this system by the Indians and it is now out of repair. Costs shown below only include the 1910 work.
