Assessments, O & M Costs, Irrigation Projects

Your memo of May 24 to Mr. Fister regarding the question as to whether or not the lands involved in the several irrigation projects on the Navajo are Tribal or allotted has been referred to me.

To the best of my knowledge the only two irrigation projects within the reservation proper where allotted lands are involved are Moenkopi-Tuba and Houck Projects. I believe that there is allotted land involved in both of the two above-mentioned projects because we have been reluctant to issue land assignments on either project without first carefully checking the status on the plots involved.

I am of the opinion that Marvin Long might be able to clarify this point.
