MEMORANDUM TO: I. R. Fryer
FROM: C. W. Wright

I am attaching a data sheet for COO-ID-EMCO co-operative project for the protection of the main canal on the agricultural land in the Upper Moencopi project.

This project provides that EMCO will furnish 1500 lineal feet of steel rail, and 1200 lineal feet of cable, which are now in the yard at Gallup.

At the present time, there are approximately 3834 lineal feet of steel rail at the Gallup yard, and we have recently received a letter from Mr. Woolke, instructing us to retain 1500 lineal feet of this rail and transfer 3000 lineal feet to the Southern jurisdictions in the Indian Service. I am assuming that, since the above project is approved, we may hold 1500 lineal feet of this rail, and transfer the balance of our stock to these other jurisdictions, and that this will meet with the approval of Mr. Woolke.

The 1500 lineal feet of rail to be used in the above-named project is now in the process of being moved to Tuba City.
