My dear Mr. Robinson:

I have finally succeeded in getting the exposures you requested in your letter of the 10th ultimo, and the entire film is being mailed to you with this letter as you will have a better chance to expedite the developing and finishing than I have here by mail.

Several of the exposures were on the film before your letter came and if you can let me have one copy of each of those it will be appreciated.

The views from the west end of the canal had to be taken in insufficient light, for the evenings have been cloudy here for almost a week, and if the pictures do not turn out well please write me and I shall make another attempt.

If you desire that I shall put captions on the pictures when completed please send them to me to have this done.

In this connection I must report that the concrete lining of the canal has caved in in several places, and that repair work must be done. Part of the lining toward the waste gate is not high enough and that too should be remedied. The work can probably be done without supervision from your department, but I should like to have your Mr. Post outline for us some time when he can come over this way just what should be done.
