MEMORANDUM FOR MR. HUNTER.

In reply to your Memorandum to me, dated August 8, 1932, with which was attached letter from the State Land Commissioner of Arizona, requesting a settlement for State grazing lands used by the Indians, I have given this file considerable study and I am convinced that it is a matter which might lead into considerable difficulty.

While the Land Commissioner does not suggest that payment be made for grazing use of these lands for the past twenty years, it might be inferred from his letter that it is what he has in mind. In view of this, I wish to discuss the matter in detail with you at your earliest convenience.
