Dear Mr. McCray:

The Office has your letter of February 26, 1934, in which you show that you have expended \$6,742.28 from Emergency Conservation funds in connection with the buying of sheep and ask that you be authorized to transfer "the balance from the Sheep Buying fund to the Emergency Conservation funds".

It is not known from your letter whether you desire to have the whole \$6,742.28 charged against the Sheep Buying fund or whether you have a lesser amount in the Sheep Buying fund which you wish to apply toward the \$6,742.28.

Before further action can be taken by the Office, you will need to furnish the Office with a schedule showing what vouchers were erroneously charged to Emergency Conservation funds, giving the number of each voucher affected, the month when paid, and when only a part of the voucher is affected the particular items and amounts involved.

Upon the receipt of the information above indicated, so that the items can be verified, suitable instructions will be given you regarding the transfer.
