Dear Mr. Wolmack:

A quantity of casing was bought from the irrigation funds allotted to this jurisdiction for range water development. The expectation was to use the casing in three wells near the jurisdiction's eastern border. It was only possible to bring in one well which was about three hundred feet in depth. At the time Mr. Cravath moved the well rig and crew from this jurisdiction he stated that the pipe would probably be used for casing in wells on the Hopi Reservation.

Would it be possible to transfer the cost of the unused casing to the Hopi encumbrance and credit this jurisdiction with that amount? In the spring it could readily be used here as you see fit for reservoir construction, improvement of wells and springs or repair of wells and springs already improved. All of these phases of water development are greatly needed. We sincerely hope that such a transfer is <sup>effected</sup> and that further water development may be made during the present fiscal year on this jurisdiction.
