Dear Mc Cray:

I have just made a trip over parts of the Navajo country checking up on construction of reservoirs, I find many of them under designed in regard to spillway, also other details not up to my original ideas of what should be carried out.

It is my intention to personally see all these reservoirs with a view of increasing spillway capacity or correcting any other detail necessary to protect them from floods. I might add that this is rather late for ^{me} to detect this discrepancy and will offer as an excuse, that all my time has been taken up with other things, so have relied too much on reports, rather than seeing for myself. I will see to it personally that whatever error may have been made in designing of reservoirs will be corrected at the earliest date possible.

I will make a special effort to be over and see you as soon as possible before the floods do any damage due to under designed spillway or other construction defects if there should be any, all of these dams may be strictly in accordance with good engineering, but if not I want to safeguard them as far as possible.
