Dear Mr Mc Cray:

This refers to reservoir work on your jurisdiction.

After looking over the country in the Bistai district, we decided that it would be rather slow and expensive to take the air compressor over in that country for shooting out reservoir spillways, therefore, we hope to do this by hand, provided we can get some drill steel for this job and return it when job is completed.

I want to get over in the near future to talk over the work in general, with a view of getting things in shape to complete the program of water development as far funds will permit this year.

Mack if there is anything you can do in the way of letting our men have steel, hammers, etc. so we may be able to do this one job we will equip ourselves for such work as soon as possible, we are trying to get this done before any rains may do farther damage to these reservoirs, also have them in shape so they will fill with the summer rains.
