


TO: Mr. Dutton and Mr. Holmes
FROM: Education and Irrigation Branches
SUBJECT: Division of Water, Moencopi-Tuba Project

During a conference at Window Rock, Arizona, on March 16, 1950, between Mr. Carmody, Mr. Hawely, Mr. Johnson, and Mr. Schriener a division of the water available for the Moencopi-Tuba Irrigation Project was agreed upon.

It was agreed that the school would get one-third and the Indians would get two-thirds on a daily-use basis. This schedule is to be worked out by Mr. Dutton and Mr. Holmes.

It was also agreed that the schools would assist the Indians in the cleaning of the ditches through the Indian lands this spring.
