Sir:

I have your letter of the second instant relative to proposal of Mr. J. L. Hubbell to surrender his present water rights and accept in lieu a water right from the Ganado Reservoir, and asking if any contract or agreement had been entered into with Mr. Hubbell, directing me, if none had been made, to draw up such a form as I deemed would cover the case.

I enclose a rough memorandum of agreement which recites the facts in the case, but may not be in the form desired by the Department.

Mr. Hubbell is in Washington at the present time I am informed, and is stopping at the Hotel Raleigh. It might be advisable to ask him to call with reference to the agreement and whatever papers are prepared could be signed by him there.

I also enclose a copy of his letter making the proposition so far as it has been made in writing.

If an agreement is made with Mr. Hubbell, I would ask to be furnished with a copy for my guidance and to be placed in my files.
