
Memorandum To: Allan G. Harper, General Superintendent

Subject : Water Supply Navajo-Hopi

During the meeting held December 5th by the Division of Resources, Navajo Area, which included Superintendent James Crawford and members of his staff, a general outline of policy was agreed upon regarding Ground-water development and maintenance.

The Water Supply Supervisor of the Navajo will furnish, upon request, technical advise or other assistance that may be required, ie., personnel or equipment for use on the Hopi reservation; likewise, the Staff-members of the Hopi reservation will make available personnel or rquipment for use on the Navajo if such is required.

The personnel furnished, by either Navajo or Hopi, will be under the direction of the Division head making the request, for the duration of the employment.

Based on past experiences and relationships between the Navajo and Hopi Ground-water divisions such services that may be required will be a definite advantage to both activities and at the same time bring about a better understanding between employees involved, since the problems of water are very similar in every respect.
