



I, Toh Tsoni, also known as Pete Toh Tsoni, a Navajo Indian, am 56 years old. I was born near ~~XXXXX~~ Castle Butte. I have a wife and seven living children. I was given an allotment, and have built a house on it, the allotment has been approved. We have about two thousand head of sheep, and more than two hundred head of cattle. We lost both cattle and sheep last winter on account of poor range. I saved most of my sheep by feeding corn to them. I am familiar with the entire Navajo Country; I do not know of any place to go if we should be deprived of the land we now occupy.
