The Indians of the Fort Defiance district are petitioning you through me to build a diversion dam on Black Creek just above the Fort. Old Pete Price has been particularly urging that this project be included in the program. He informs me that Mr. Burns looked over this and considered it favorably.

In view of the unanimous approval of this project by the Navajos, I would be particularly pleased if you would give it every possible consideration.

Will you kindly advise the probabilities in this case in order that I may inform the Indians.
