
~~I have the honor to enclose herewith copy of a decree of~~
the District Court of Cochise County Arizona, enjoining the Nava-
jo Indians from constructing a ditch in the Moon Copie Wash.

The dam referred to has been one of the sources of trouble
between the whites and Indians near Tuba City.

I would respectfully recommend that the enclosed decree be
referred to Col. Faison, Inspector, who has, I believe, recently
visited the vicinity of Tuba City and may have warned the Indians
sufficiently to prevent their interference with the dam in future.
If he has not done so it would seem to me that some one should be
sent to Tuba City to do so.
