



Sir:

I have the honor to ask the Office to send this office two copies of the plain map of the Navajo Country, Arizona, New Mexico and Utah, produced by the U. S. Geological Survey. I do not want the colored Geologic map. Size of the maps wanted is about 25 x 31 inches and on white paper.

I want to use these maps for platting the wells and water holes on the Hopi Reserve so that we will have a complete record of them. This can only be done on a white outline map.
