Sir:

The Office incloses herewith a copy of a letter from H. H. Miller, Superintendent of the Moqui Agency, dated September 26, 1910, relative to the settlement of a factional dispute which was brought about when the question of allotting arose.

You are requested to investigate the feasibility of a diversion dam, as suggested in Mr. Miller's letter, and report at your earliest convenience. If the scheme is found practicable, will there be sufficient funds from the \$50,000 apportionment to the Navajo and Moqui reservations to complete the work during the present fiscal year?
