Enclosed herewith is a copy of another letter received from the Indian Office in regard to the allotment matters on the Moqui Reservation. It seems that this whole business hinges upon the practicability of this scheme of Murphy's.

As soon as you get the bridge matter out of the way, I recommend that you proceed to the Moqui Agency and investigate this proposition, since the Office is apparently anxious to get the matter settled. If the plan has any merit we want to consider it, and if not, it should be turned down and disposed of.

Please advise me about what date you expect to return to Albuquerque with the Roebling Engineer. I may be able to get there at the same time in order to discuss the matter before he proceeds east.
