

The Secretary of the Interior.

My dear Mr. Secretary:

In accordance with a request of the Hopi Tribe, and pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984), as amended by the Act of June 15, 1935, (49 Stat. 378), an order was approved by you on September 30, 1936, which submitted the attached Constitution and By-laws to the voters of the Hopi Tribe for their ratification or rejection on October 24, 1936.

It is my great pleasure to inform you that the attached document was ratified by a vote of 651 to 104, the total vote cast (755) amounting to more than thirty per cent of the eligible voters (1671). Your approval of the Constitution and By-laws is therefore recommended.
