

Your letter of November 11 calling attention to the letter of Mr. S. M. Brosius, agent of the Indian Rights Association, with regard to allotments to the Navajo Indians on the public domain in Cocconino Basin, Arizona, is at hand. I am writing Mr. Brosius today and enclose herewith a copy of my letter to him, which explains my position. I have made inquiry and cannot agree with you in your statement that Mr. Tipton's report was apparently based upon information drawn from sources hostile to the interests of the Indians.
