Dear Mr. Morton:

In our letter dated October 2, 1958, we recommended that the United States not appear in the case of Willard Sakiesteva v. Paul Jones, et al. as an advocate for either the Hopis or Navajos (Your reference: REM:PLF 90-2-11-6742).

Our letter enclosed two copies of a memorandum dated September 26, 1958, from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs which furnished background information on the controversy.

We are enclosing with this letter two copies of a new memorandum from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs which revokes and supersedes his September 26 memorandum, for reasons that are indicated therein.
