My Dear Mr. Commissioner;

I have the honor to inform you that at a meeting of the Indians of the Leupp Jurisdiction held here today attended by 120 Indians, Hosteen Begoiden Bega was elected delegate and Pesh La Kai Etsetty was elected alternate delegate from the Leupp Jurisdiction for a four year term beginning June 1st, 1923.

I am assured by Mr. Janus and by others that these two men are among the best of the Indians of this Jurisdiction and they appear to me to be well qualified for the positions. Indians present at the meeting seemed to be thoroughly interested in the situation and it appears that they have been very fully discussing the matter among themselves. At the meeting they expressed confidence that the Government and the Commissioner to the Navajo Tribe would do everything possible for their welfare.

I enclose a copy of the minutes of the said meeting, the original of which I am retaining in my files.

I shall proceed to Tuba City tomorrow.
