I have the honor to inclose herewith for your information and consideration a copy of a letter from the Superintendent of the Leupp Indian School, Leupp, Arizona, wherein he calls attention to the marriage relations of Joe Williams, an Indian under his jurisdiction, and to suggest and recommend that the United States Attorney be instructed to take such action as the law and the facts may warrant.

In the event that instructions are issued, as above suggested, and on receipt of advice thereof through this Department, the Commissioner of Indian Affairs will direct the Superintendent to render the United States Attorney such assistance as he may desire.
