My dear Mr. Commissioner:

I have the honor to advise you that at a regular meeting of the Navajo Tribal Council duly called and held in accordance with the Departmental Regulations of April 24, 1923, relating to the Navajo Tribe of Indians, there was unanimously passed by the said Council a resolution granting to the Commissioner of the Navajo Tribe authority to sign oil leases on behalf of the Navajo Indians, and authorizing the Secretary of the Interior to grant 4,800 acre leases on separate structures.
