Miscellaneous projects, \$5,000.
Hogback Ditch, All that can be spared,
Work on Moki springs etc. \$1,000

Jicarilla Apache, Authority to be renewed, \$3,500.

Allotted Southern Utes, ?

Pueblos, \$5,000.

Salaries, per diem, office rent etc.
I suppose that this last need not be specifically mentioned, but it has to be met.
