Dear Sir:

I am in receipt of a letter from the Indian Office relative to the assignment of an expert of the Geological Survey to make investigations in Navajo and Moki Reservation as follows:

"Referring to your letter of December 25 relative to an investigation of the possibilities of underground water development on the Navajo and Moqui Reservations, the Department on December 9 authorized the office to advise the Director of the Geological Survey that when funds become available, which will probably be so soon after the first of March next, he will be requested to have an expert on underground waters development investigate and report as to the possibilities of obtaining water on the Navajo and Moqui Reservations, and that authority will be given for the transfer of \$3,000 to the credit of the appropriation for "Gauging Streams, U. S. Geological Survey".

When the funds become available your request that the man detailed be directed to meet you at Albuquerque for a conference in the matter will be taken up with the Geological Survey."
