WATER

Pursuant to Title 37, Arizona Revised Statutes, the State of Arizona through the Arizona State Land Department (the Department) offers for sale the right to remove WATER. Public Auction Sale No. 126GW20 will be held at 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 19, 1987, at the north entrance to the Yavapai County Courthouse in Prescott, Arizona.

Any person who desires to protest any of the terms of this auction shall file a written protest with the Department within thirty days after the first day of publication of the terms of the proposed auction. All protests shall state specifically the term or terms of the auction to which objection is made and state specifically the reasons for each objection. An objection not specifically stated or timely made is deemed to be waived.

(E) If water is to be drawn from a designated Active Management Area or Irrigation Non-expansion area, permission in the form of a Groundwater Withdrawal Permit or other permit, must be obtained from the Department of Water Resources prior to use of the water.

MEMORANDUM

The Department of Water Resources has appraised the water subject to the Bagdad applications to purchase at \$35.00/acre foot. Pursuant to your letter to W. Dempsey Helms dated July 21, 1986, Cyprus Bagdad agreed to that appraised amount, but requested changes in the annual minimum.

The annual minimum set by the Department of Water Resources and annual royalty amounts and the annual minimum requested by Cyprus and annual royalty amounts are as follows:
