Reference is made to our letter dated July 25, 1949, concerning termination of an Agreement dated December 6, 1943, between the Southern Pacific Company and the Government, covering the construction and operation of a fuel oil unloading pipe line and portions of an underground steel storage tank on S. P. property at Fort Huachuca, Arizona.

In your reply dated August 4, 1949, you advised that notice of termination action of the above agreement was being referred to the Arizona National Guard for their recommendation.
