It was originally contemplated that those portions of Fort Huachuca Military Reservation which were repossessed by letter of 18 January 1951 would be utilized by the Department of the Air Force.

Due to the Department of the Army's requirements, it has been resolved that this reservation would be utilized by the Department of the Army. For the purpose of the record I wish to reaffirm that the Department of the Army continues to have an urgent need for the use of those portions of the Fort Huachuca Military Reservation described in letter from the Department of the Air Force on 18 January 1951.
