The Arizona Department of Water Resources (Department) will hold two meetings on April 19th as part of the Planning Area Stakeholder Process for the Cochise Planning Area, which is located in southeastern Arizona (see attached map). These are the second in a series of meetings to examine water resource demand and challenges for the area.

The goal of both meetings is to begin the process of updating existing information for the region. The first meeting ("Demand Sector Data", 1-3 pm) will focus on demand data for agricultural, municipal, and industrial use sectors. The second meeting ("Background and Mitigation", 4-6 pm) will focus on background information and discussion of both previously identified and new opportunities for mitigation strategies.



