

## ADWR REGULATORY AGENDA FOR 2018

This document was produced by the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) to comply with A.R.S. § 41-1021.02. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1021.02(D), ADWR may undertake a rulemaking even if the rulemaking is not included on the annual regulatory agenda.

Note: On January 11, 2017, Governor Ducey issued Executive Order 2017-02, “Internal Review of Administrative Rules; Moratorium to Promote Job Creation and Customer-Service-Oriented Agencies.” The Executive Order provides that a state agency shall not conduct any rulemaking without the prior written approval of the Office of the Governor. Currently, ADWR has not requested permission to conduct any rulemaking in 2018, but plans to seek permission in December 2017 for the anticipated rulemaking activity described in section I below.
