ADWR Director plans statewide speaking tour

Arizona Department of Water Resources Director Herb Guenther will undertake a statewide speaking schedule this month to present a series of rural water resource proposals for public consideration.

The Director plans to discuss proposals developed by the Statewide Water Advisory Group (SWAG) during the meetings the 50-plus-member group has held over the past several months.

The proposals to be discussed focus on four recommendations developed by the members of SWAG.

The recommendations are:

1. Cities, towns and counties need the authority to approve or disapprove developments based on the availability of an adequate supply of water,
2. A water development fund should be established,
3. A pilot rural water supply development and management district should be established, and
4. ADWR should maintain oversight for:
 - The establishment of water rights and
 - Technical evaluations for determination of adequacies, and
 - ADWR should continue to provide planning and technical assistance.

The SWAG was formed at the request of Arizona Gov. Janet Napolitano as a means of assisting local residents to reach common ground on water needs for Arizona's diverse communities. The group has been meeting every two weeks since May 5, 2006 and is hoping to develop its findings into measures that can be introduced at the 2007 session of the Legislature.

"People were surprised initially to learn that diverse regions of Arizona had common water-resource issues," Guenther said. "The group has come together on a number of strategies for assuring that growth can be accommodated without placing undue stress on the limited resources of this arid environment."
