## Arizona Conserve Water Workshop June 27

The Prescott Active Management Area office is holding an Arizona Conserve Water Workshop for educators from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 27<sup>th</sup>, at the Yavapai County Cooperative Extension Office, 840 Rodeo Drive #C, Prescott.

"I believe that providing teachers with the tools and support they deserve will go a long way toward making Arizona students the most water-aware pupils in the nation," said Herb Guenther, Director of the Arizona Department of Water Resources.

Arizona Project WET is conducting this one-of-a-kind professional development opportunity for teachers, educators, and water resource staff. The focus is on Arizona's water resources and specifically water conservation.
