ADWR to continue series of workshops on water adequacy law

The Arizona Department of Water Resources will resume its series of statewide workshops explaining the new water adequacy law and the development of an accompanying set of rules.

The Department will hold a series of meetings to seek public input of the draft rules, running through the summer of 2008, listed below. The first meeting will be Thursday, May 15 in Flagstaff.

"At the upcoming meetings in May and June, the Department will be providing a user-friendly overview of the new state law and our proposals for water-availability requirements," said Sandra Fabritz-Whitney, assistant director for water management.
