## Arizona Department of Water Resources to hold meeting to discuss water conditions in the Mohave County area

PHOENIX (June 14, 2016) - The Arizona Department of Water Resources (Department) will hold a meeting on June 29th to discuss water conditions in the Northwest Basins Planning Area, which is located northwest of Phoenix (see attached map). This meeting is the first of a series of meetings to examine water resource demand and challenges for the area.

The meeting will include an overview of groundwater conditions for the area and a preview of existing regulatory tools available. During the meeting, the public will have the opportunity to provide information regarding their water concerns to the Department.

This meeting and future meetings are part of Governor Ducey's Water Initiative for the State. Through the Planning Area Stakeholder Process, the Department will work closely with rural areas and local stakeholders to define their water resource challenges and identify strategies that will be successful in assisting with meeting future water demands.



On October 5, 2015, Governor Ducey announced his Water Initiative to help ensure the certainty and vitality of Arizona's water supplies for future generations. In addition to the Planning Area Stakeholder Process, the Water Initiative involves the creation of the Governor's Water Augmentation Council, which will investigate long-term water augmentation strategies, additional water conservation opportunities, funding, and infrastructure needs to help secure water supplies for Arizona's future.
