ALLOCATIONS OF CENTRAL ARIZONA PROJECT (CAP) WATER**

Avra Water Co-Op Inc., a member co-operative located within the Tucson Active Management Area, proposes to transfer its 808 acre-feet Central Arizona Project (CAP) water entitlement to the Town of Marana, a designated provider, that will directly use the entitlement in the near term to meet its existing groundwater demands. The proposed transfer will be evaluated by the Arizona Department of Water Resources (Department) in accordance with the Department's February 27, 2006, revised CAP water transfer policy.
