RINSE SMART

Water-efficient Spray Valves



AVAILABLE VALVES

The Arizona Department of Water Resources has a limited supply of water- and energy-saving spray valves to provide to municipalities, private water companies, and other eligible applicants throughout Arizona for installation in food service facilities. The valves are available on a first come, first serve basis for as long as supplies last or until November 30, 2010, whichever comes first.

CONSERVING WATER

Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) was created to secure long-term dependable water supplies for Arizona's communities and administers several programs that support its mission. The Conservation Program promotes and encourages the wise use of water by providing education and outreach, community assistance, program development, water-efficient technologies and conservation tools throughout the state.

To help foster water-efficient practices and the use of water-efficient technologies, ADWR is providing the "Rinse Smart" valves. These valves are rated at 1.6 gallons per minute in contrast to older valves that can use up to 5 gpm. Examples of facilities that use spray valves include: restaurants; grocery store bakeries, delis and meat departments; and cafeterias in schools, hospitals, and businesses.

Providing water-efficient pre-rinse spray valves will result in quantifiable water savings and have the added benefit of advancing education and public awareness on water conservation issues, active citizen involvement, innovative approaches to water conservation, and long-term results.

REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to identify a target audience and get the valves installed
- Ability to verify that valves are replacing ones that are not water-efficient
- Verification that you will not charge for the valves or the installation
- Filling out and returning the back side of this flier to ADWR
