- ▶ 2013 Statewide Area Burned: 104,748 Acres
- ▶ 2013 Statewide # of Fires: 1648 Fires

Across all jurisdictions

## Large Fires – 100 acres +


- ▶ 31 fires of more than 100 acres

- ▶ To 08/17, the French Gulch incident
- ▶ Total of 95,105 acres
- ▶ 18 fires of greater than 1000 acres








# Visual Greenness

possible green






## Departure from Average
