Subject: Redfield Canyon Green Sunfish Removal

Hello,

The effort yesterday to remove green sunfish from Redfield Canyon went well with four sunfish being removed. Participants divided into three crews to cover as much habitat as possible. The crew working the lowermost section did not capture any green sunfish nor were any observed. The crews working the middle and upper sections successfully removed four green sunfish and they did observe a few sunfish in the deep pools, but green sunfish numbers appear to have decreased from previous visits. The two crews working the upper sections also netted a loach minnow in breeding colors from one of the pools they were working in. Overall, it was a great day with a great group of participants (Duane, John, Suzy, Bob, Jony, Jeff, and Diane).
