

I/we strongly and respectfully object to any possible encroachment, infringement or restriction on our right to access water for domestic, agricultural or animal husbandry use from the Coconino Aquifer and Little Colorado River System upon which our 40 acre property located at 5276 Joken Rd. in Antelope Valley Arizona, titled to Philip and Rebecca Rohkohl, legally described as SECTION 5, T14N, R17E: SE4 SE4 in Navajo County Arizona, Assessor Book #201 Map #36 Parcel #016, specifically located outside of the Hopi Reservation Lands. I/we pray the court to affirm the decision of Judge Ballenger's minute order of November 4, 2004 wherein the court "Limited the Hopi FSR to reservation Lands."




