



OBJECTION BOOKLET

An Objection Form is included in this booklet that must be used to file an objection to the Final Hopi Hydrographic Survey Report (HSR). An objection to the Final Hopi HSR must be in writing and be notarized. The deadline for filing an objection is **June 15, 2016**.

Only persons who have filed a statement of claimant in the Little Colorado River adjudication may file an objection to the Final Hopi HSR, but are not required to do so. An objection must be made on a legal or factual basis to ADWR's proposed water right attributes, which are found in Chapter 5 of the Final Hopi HSR. Persons who object on a legal or factual basis also may comment on other portions of the Final Hopi HSR. An objection must state in clear and concise language the legal and/or factual reasons for the objection together with a brief description of the evidence to support those reasons. Additional information or documentation may be attached to the Objection Form.

The original copy of the notarized Objection Form and two copies (including any attachments) must be filed and *received* by the Clerk of the Apache County Superior Court by no later than **June 15, 2016**. There is no filing fee for objections. Copies of the Objection Form and any attachments also must be sent to counsel for the Hopi Tribe and counsel for the United States. Addresses for the Clerk of the Apache County Superior Court, counsel for the Hopi Tribe and counsel for the United States are included on the Objection Form.

Court proceedings will be scheduled at a later date to address objections that have been filed. Those persons who file an objection will receive notice of these proceedings. Information about court orders and deadlines may be found at the following website:
